This comprehensive training covers key food safety concepts such as: personal hygiene, cross contamination, time and temperature, receiving and storage, food safety management systems, training hourly employees, as well as the Ohio supplemental content.

Upon successful completion of the training and receiving a passing score on the exam, participants receive both the ODH *Ohio Manager Certification in Food Protection* and the ServSafe® Food Protection Manager certificates.
